EDITORIAL**"ALIENS" - HERE, THERE AND EVERYWHERE!**

One of the overlooked facets of our subject is who can adjudicate on just who or what is an "alien"? Many forgeries exist! In my professional field of Stamp Dealing, rarer items are sent to an expertisation committee to obtain a certificate of genuineness or otherwise. Usually there is somebody who can advise even on obscure items from Eastern Europe or South America. In the case of "aliens" there are no committees available to judge and the ones described in abduction cases never put in an appearance at public meetings. All evidence available is entirely anecdotal other than the odd suspicious photograph.

The only "aliens" one ever meets look exactly like "Joe Public", but somehow claim to be not from our noble stock of "homo sapiens". Yes they look the same as our physical selves but possess the souls of master beings from out there in the universe! This concept is a well used theme in science fiction writing. It does assume there is a spiritual content or "soul" connected to a person - a fact not all agree with. (However I am now convinced of the existence of this energy).

Our recent contact with the supposed 41,000 years old "RA" (see last Awareness 243 pp 26-7) was enhanced when the claimant appeared in person at our last meeting in June. A casual invitation had been made after correspondence, but, by the nature of these things, RA's actual arrival was unexpected. He turned out to be smartly dressed in a suit - a good 5 feet 10 inches tall, and an Earth age of around 35. There were no strange clothes or decorations save for a multiplicity of male type neck chains. The presence of glasses gave the first impression he was not quite the supreme being claimed. RA gave us some tapes which I was expecting to reveal the secrets of the universe - sadly not - it turned out to be some beaty music which didn't explain anything. He also had impressionist style paintings of boats or rivers - again very "human". What about a dematerialisation or a small miracle just to show proof? Afraid not! RA gave a talk for about an hour which was adventurous - telling us things about stars we couldn't possibly know about, but nor could anybody else who had not left the Solar System. Just where he was coming from, the few of us present at the meeting could not be too sure.

A few weeks later, an envelope full of invitations arrived at our address inviting us to attend a seminar at Swindon given by "one of the world's greatest living mystics" - "YAH". The blurb stated: "He is the Soul-Essence of a Pleiades extraterrestrial from another time reality who came to this physical reality through the means of a Soul-Transference-Division into an already existing Earth human body of 10 years of old. YAH presently occupies simultaneously this Earth body and also his other Pleiades body now existing in the future Pleiades." It was suggested that a "donation" of £120 was made to attend the seminar over a weekend although a free Friday evening introductory talk was offered.

I was not persuaded to blow £120 inspite of the wonderful prospectus before me! Lots of chat about Soul Transference and Space Confederations (bureaucracy seems as bad out there as it is here on Earth!) and no doubt very convincing presentation from Mr YAH, who could, one suspects, sell sand to Arabs!

When do we get to see the pukka physical alien - he who has not borrowed our body! Wonderfully described "greys" are pictured all over books and magazines, but never turn up

at meetings, whereas ordinary folk with "alien souls" are becoming common place. One suspect the latter are possibly social misfits who conveniently pigeon-hole their problems as a state of "Alien-ness". Others may be super slick charismatic types who know how to milk the herd. Incidentally, why do these alien contenders invariably boast male gender - should be reported to the Equal Opportunities Commission!

Arguments rage over whether the number of UFOs being reported is diminishing into the new millennium. This seems to have been brought about by the Denis Plunkett interview in the press over the closure of his British Flying Saucer Bureau - which he now refutes (see Errata page 4). There is no accurate way of telling. With so much hardware moving about in the sky one might expect an increase in UFO reports, but when observers are aware there are masses of man made objects on view, they are maybe less inclined or able to pick out the unusual. We know for sure there is massive apathy in many aspects of life. The ultimate test - the voter turn out in this year's General Election (UK) sunk to a derisory 59%, down from 71% in 1997 which in turn was down from 75% in 1992 - and to think of all those that sacrificed life and limb to get the franchise for all men and women only 100 years ago.

When I glimpsed the files of the late Ron West (Essex UFO Group) some years ago, I was amazed to see there was scarcely a day when no UFOs were reported from somewhere in the world. Then Ron went out of his way to get every group's reports. Sheer tenaciousness is not something we see a lot of these days which may explain most of the lack of UFO reports.

Viewing the "Blue Planet" series on BBC Television, the second programme showed incredible life forms living in the sea below 1000 metres. At this level there is almost total darkness and enormous pressure, yet these creatures have evolved here - many almost fully transparent and able to give off light in the form of bio-luminescence. Could it be equally possible that there is life existing on the fringes of space at the edge of Earth's atmosphere - so explaining some UFO reports? We have recently reported strange luminous objects derived from NASA footage. These could be life forms that have existed for millions of years and are part of Earth's evolution. They are therefore not "alien". The main problem is finding a way of studying them if they do exist.

Our sincere condolences must go out to American readers over the tragic events of September 11th. If ever the evil masterminds sponsoring these terrorists came to power, it would mean the end of our free way of life - this magazine would be amongst the first to go - substituted by some fundamentalist dogma and your editor probably imprisoned! My assessment, if it is of any comfort, is that this strike took years of planning and probably could never be repeated now that the world has woken up. We should note the really big events happen when least expected - never predicted by astrologers or clairvoyants until the day after when Nostradamus was, of course, found to have predicted it all along!

NEWS IN BRIEF

MARTIAN LIFE - CONCLUSIVE EVIDENCE? Traces of living organisms have been found in 2 meteorites purporting to come from Mars according to a new book "Mars: The Inside Story of the Red Planet", by Dr Heather Couper and Nigel Henbest. After the see-saw opinions on the first NASA investigated Martian meteorite, ALH 84001, found in

Antarctica, the authors reveal that scientists at Johnson Space Centre in Houston, Texas have found "conclusive" evidence in 2 other samples - the Nakhla meteorite, found in Egypt in 1911, which landed in a shower of stones and had little chance to pick up contamination, and one which fell near the Indian village of Shergotty in 1860. The three samples of rock are all from different time periods - ALH 84001, 4 billion years old; Nakhla, 600-700 million years; Shergotty, 165 million years.

Scientists are now speculating that life forms arriving from Mars in this way could have triggered off life on Earth, back 4 billion years. Looking from the point of view of the layman, the conclusions being reached look particularly far-fetched. How certain are we these meteorites came from Mars? The isotope content is said to be unique to Martian rock and if NASA says they come from Mars, then they must do! However, what the scientists consider here as "life" is barely rising above the parapet, and not very relevant to Ufology.

FRED HOYLE: One of the greatest scientists of the 20th century, Sir Fred Hoyle, has died aged 86. It is not our usual habit to comment on the deceased in this arena, but Fred Hoyle did contribute a great deal to Ufology with his unorthodox approach to scientific subjects.

He was best known in the field of astronomy particularly on the nature of the origins of the universe. At Cambridge in 1948 he postulated the "Steady State" theory of the universe, which claimed the cosmos has always existed, as opposed to the "Big Bang" theory promoted by his rivals - although today the latter theory seems to hold sway. (In any case, how can we be possibly sure about any origin?)

During the 1970s he developed the idea that life on Earth was seeded by molecules of DNA or bacteria from deep space. The "panspermia" concept has been discussed in various articles in Awareness and the latest research of Professor Wickramasinghe indicates unidentified bacteria being captured on the outer edges of the atmosphere. He also linked the passage of comets to the flu epidemics down on terra firma.

There was also science fiction writing with titles "The Black Cloud" and "A For Andromeda". Hoyle should have received a Nobel Prize for physics in 1983, but he may have been snubbed for his outspoken attacks on scientific orthodoxy.



NATIONAL SKYWATCH AT RENDLESHAM FOREST: Members of several groups and individuals took part in a national skywatch hosted by Strange Phenomena Investigations (England) on July 14th, 2001, at the spot where very major UFO activity was reported next to the USAF, Bentwaters, airbase just after Christmas 1980. A detailed report of what occurred has been forwarded by organiser, Malcolm Robinson. (Available at P.O Box 23). Of the 32 people present, there were some who claimed to have experienced phenomena while others did not. When a CIUFOR team visited the site 4 years ago, odd and, at times, anti-social behaviour from members of other groups present was reported - as if the history of the place demanded a certain amount of "hype". Thus, should groups or individuals with differing aims assemble together at such a notorious site, their interactions possibly lead to a loss of objectivity. That is the overall impression one gets from the SPI report, the

conclusions of which are set out below.

"CLOSING THOUGHTS: Many people come to Rendlesham Forest, each with their own thoughts, feelings and expectations; there is no denying that the place holds a certain "something". Most researchers agree that way beyond the principal Rendlesham Forest Incident, there were many unexplainable events which occurred there, and, as we have seen above, are still occurring. We have learned however that there are some people who would appear to see things which other people do not! What does this tell us? Are their visions real or are they all wishful expectant thinking? Sceptics would suggest the latter. What we have to bear in mind though is that there is no smoke without fire. Clearly an incident of immense proportions occurred at Rendlesham Forest back in the winter of 1980. As a researcher into strange phenomenon, the Rendlesham Forest incident stands as a major British mystery. Admittedly there appears to be a lot of disinformation which surrounds this case. Was that purposefully done to muddy the waters? Was the incident nothing other than a new prototype aerial object of our own which got into difficulty and overshot the Bentwaters runway, crashing into the forest, and a UFO cover story put out to take the sting out of what it truly was? Or, as UFOlogists would have us believe, this truly was a craft from somewhere else of which it's purpose is unknown? At the end of the day the Rendlesham Forest mystery will probably remain just that unless some earth shattering witness testimony comes to light - but the UFO subject is never usually that revealing and I can only hope that, whatever the truth is, of what happened at Rendlesham, will see the light of day eventually." OXFORD CENTRE FOR CROP CIRCLE STUDIES: The balance of the funds remaining in the OCCCS bank account - namely £107 - has been transferred to the CIUFOR current account. We are extremely grateful for this injection of capital.

MARS PROBE ARRIVES INTACT: The latest NASA probe to Mars, Mars Odyssey, entered orbit around October 25th 2001 after a 6 month journey from Earth. One of its aims is to scan the planet for signs of sub-surface water ice - an essential ingredient for life. At the early stages an orbit of 18 hours is in place, but the eventual aim is to bring it closer to the surface settling down to a nearly circular 2 hour orbit by January 2002.

Apparently the failure of the previous Climate Orbiter was because scientists had done their calculations in metric scales, whereas the engineers that built it used feet and inches! (Sounds too corny to be true!)

GROUND MARKS IN CORNISH CLAY PIT: In early January 2001 at a china clay mine between St Austell and Newquay, Cornwall, there were 4 oval marks of 20ft to 30ft diameter imprinted in the ground, with bare foot imprints of only 4 toes positioned all around them. This was seen by all the people living in houses around the quarry. Nothing was seen or heard prior to the discovery as far as we know to date, but the military arrived very soon the following morning and cordoned off the quarry for several days. This brief report was given to me from a gentleman living in Croydon, Surrey who got it from his friend, Mike, living in Newquay, whose friend, Peter, was one of the witnesses in the area who saw it himself. Apparently local UFO groups did not investigate the happenings, so we are still left in the dark. (Information Cr: Margaret Fry, North Wales)

ERRATA: In Awareness 24.3, (i) With regard to Vera Perry's case, Ohio, USA, p12, the programme should be "Nick at Night" not "Kick" run by "Nickelodeon" not "Kickelodeon".

(ii) "UFO VIDEO EARNS £20,000", p4 - a fuller explanation of this case has been received from Omar Fowler who reports that the size of the object was somewhat exaggerated. (See letters section).

(iii) "OLDEST UFO SOCIETY CLOSES", p3-4 - Denis Plunkett, the founder of the British Flying Saucer Bureau, has informed us the group is still operating and will resume meetings in the Autumn. He has complained to the Press Council about the accuracy of the report in the Times. (Seems to have been in several other papers too.) This particular piece seems to have generated a fair amount of bad publicity in one way or another, so lets just wish BFSB good luck in the future.

STOP PRESS - EAST COAST MASS SIGHTING: Another large, spectacular "meteor" display was reported on Saturday, October 27th, 2001 at 8.30pm. There was a very large explosion sited over the North Sea followed by a brilliant flash. The spectacle was viewed from Hastings on the Sussex coast up to Lincolnshire, covering about 200 miles. It was also seen from Holland.

Thames coastguard HQ on the Essex coast said their switchboard had been jammed even receiving calls from cross-channel ferries and oil rigs in the North Sea. There was again a trail across the sky lasting for half an hour, similar to previous cases of this type. In spite of experienced observers on the sea feeling a need to report the incident, the press consulted the Royal Astronomical Society who, as always, rationalised it by quoting some obscure meteor shower, the Orionids. These are not even mentioned in our astronomy notes in Awareness 24.2, p25, as being likely to cause a highly visible display. The next lively shower should be the Leonids between Nov 16-18th, which are often quoted as being spectacular, but over UK skies have never raised a ripple of excitement in 10 years.

This mass display is a continuation of several similar events we have been monitoring since 1992. In fact on May 29th, 1994, an almost identical scenario occurred off the east coast of England, on Bank Holiday Monday in daylight from 10.30 to noon with coastguard switchboards again jammed. As in the present case there was vast amounts of light seen but no wreckage ever found. See detailed reports of these events in Awareness 22.4 p12-15.

It seems highly unlikely that huge meteors could be targeting Britain as many as a dozen times in 10 years, so what really is going on? At the time of these reports nothing seems to have been reported in other countries a long way off, as might be expected if a large meteor shower is hitting the Earth's atmosphere.

As in several other of these events, secondary UFO activity was being reported conjointly with the main spectacular. CIUFOR received a call from Bingham, Notts, stating that 4 witnesses had seen lights above cloud or mist at exactly the same time, 8.30 pm, on October 27th. These changed colour from red/orange/blue and white and then zoomed off south east.

We will try to establish the extent of the activity in the next issue. Strange to relate there was a small earthquake, 3.8 on the Richter scale over the East Midlands the following day, October 28th, and what is described as a continuous aircraft noise being experienced by several people in the Oxford and Worcester areas on October 29th.

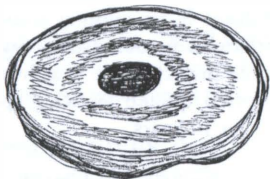
Place: Bonsall, Derbyshire UK

The Headlines of the Daily Star read *UFDough*, a housewife Sharon Rowlands had captured a UFO on video and apparently been handsomely paid by an American TV Company as it rates among the best top five videos ever taken of a UFO. NASA officials have been asked to examine the footage before it is screened Worldwide.

Sharon was filming a flashing object up to three miles wide as it hovered over the Derbyshire village for six minutes. The object appeared to be a giant disc with a "bite" out of it. The UFO appeared to expand then get smaller as it hovered in the sky, it was covered with yellow, orange and blue lights and had a darker centre. It beamed pulses of light before blasting away in a red flash.

The Met Office confirmed that there were no freak weather conditions that night to explain the sighting.

NASA has taken a similar image by one of their own cameras, during a space shuttle mission.

Farmer Irwel Evans was greeted with hundreds of pieces of honeycombed metal foil strewn over an area the size of three football pitches on tending his newly born lambs. The Sunday Express headline was *Mystery of the Strange Debris from Sky*. Huge twisted alloy plates painted green on one side, grey on the other lay everywhere and in a nearby copse, branches had been sheared off trees.

Mr. Evans telephoned the Police and they took away fragments of metal for analysis. A team of uniformed RAF men with plain clothes officers combed the land and nearby woods by using flashlights as darkness began to fall.

Among the debris were an aerial and a large chunk of metal with part of a serial number on it.

Everyone concerned was convinced that whatever it was that covered Mr Evans's field had fallen out of the sky, but after two weeks the riddle still remained. Police are baffled so too are the RAF.

No-one in the close-knit Welsh community heard a plane that night. Nothing unusual showed up on RAF radar scanners.

Mr Evans farms his land single handed and stated that whatever tumbled from the sky broke up on impact, it must have been a fair size as wreckage was scattered across four field. Had it hit a building there's no doubt the devastation could have been terrible.

A Mrs M. and Mr G was looking through their kitchen window when they first saw a round solid object which was very very bright. Mrs M. went outside to call her dogs in and saw it was a very bright light in the sky. After studying this for 10 minutes or so she went inside and got her camcorder and looking through the lens of her video camera recorded the sighting which lasted roughly 40 minutes. She estimated the size of the object to be 30 – 50feet across at a distance of 300 yards or so. She stated the object was stationary straight above her then moved rapidly to the right so fast she could not keep up with it. The object made no sound and the general weather conditions were very overcast, cloudy, cold and windy. Mrs M states that there were no stars, just the UFO which hung very low.

She was concerned by what she had seen and contacted the Ministry of Defence who replied to her letter as follows:-

• I am writing with referencè to your report of a sighting of an 'unidentified flying object' on 13th April 2001. The report was passed to this office by the Aeronautical Information Service (Military) at RAF West Drayton as we are the focal point within the Ministry of Defence for correspondence relating to 'UFOs'.

They go on to say:-

• First it may be helpful if I explain that the Ministry of Defence examines any reports of 'unidentified flying objects' it receives solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance, namely, whether there is any evidence that the United Kingdom's airspace might have been comprised by hostile or unauthorised air activity. Unless there is evidence of a potential threat, and to date no 'UFO' report has revealed such evidence, MOD does not attempt to identify the precise nature of each reported sighting. We believe it is possible that rational explanations such as aircraft, lights or natural phenomena could be found for them, but it is not the function of the MOD to provide this kind of aerial identification service. We could not justify expenditure of public funds on investigations which go beyond our specific defence remit.

They did go on to conclude that Mrs M could send her video tape to themselves and they would attempt to identify the precise nature of the sighting.

Mrs M was concerned by the tone and contents of the letter from the MOD as she stated "it is very worrying" presumably as they are not taking any responsibility for anything that sits in the sky and observes, but once the big guns fire then they will then take action!

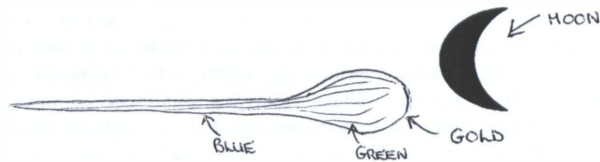

On 3rd November 2000 at 19.08hrs a couple were walking their dog in a lane near Hingham. Walking in a south westerly direction there was enough light from the crescent moon to see by and the sky was

clear. Suddenly the landscape lit up around them with a bright white light. The light appeared to come from behind them and they mistakenly thought it was a car's headlights coming from their rear, but on turning around they saw a large object in the sky, travelling parallel to the lane and slightly below the level of the moon. It travelled in a straight line very fast across the sky and disappeared approximately 20 degrees above the horizon ahead of them.

The object was about half the size of the moon and round like a spring onion bulb. The head was gold trailing into green and blue. The whole episode took about two and a half to three seconds.

The male witness made the original sketch immediately on arriving home so that it was fresh in his mind.

They viewed this strange phenomena for 2 minutes and stated that the sky was very clear and they could see a pink hue with blue and purple lights travelling from West to East moving silently.

We have no other reports of this sighting.

A Ms IC wrote in to tell us of her recent sighting after reading our magazine AWARENESS and felt she would like to share this with us.

She was watching the skies with a friend when they saw big stars that suddenly moved around, she said it was like watching the stars playing and this continued for approximately 30 minutes. Finally a big star "closed" and moved away overhead.

They recently both saw a star, which descended slowly from a tiny speck down in a straight line getting bigger as it descended. It suddenly stopped, and drifted off slowly into the distance.

Bright White Lights were seen hovering low over the gravel pit in Lodge/Low's Farm, St. Osyth about 3 miles from Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, about 300 yards (metres) away on 8th June at 0015 hours. The object moved slowly to within 100 yards of the observer and hovered.

The Car Radio turned itself off.

The object was about 8 feet wide and made a low pitched whine. A pale green light was now seen in its centre. It appeared to be butterfly shaped although other details might have been obscured by the dazzling white lights.

Later it moved upwards, then descended and moved from side to side. It rotated through one revolution and then sped off, making a crackling noise as it ascended.

It then disappeared in a blinding flash of blue light.

The observer said that time seemed to have stood still during the 25 minutes he had watched the object.

At first the witness thought it might be lights to enable gravel extraction – he said it was definitely not a helicopter.

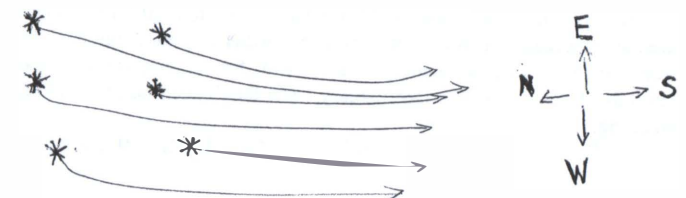

A Mr CJC was in his rear garden on the night of the 27th August 2001 where he was observing through binoculars the clear night sky and studying the moon. He stated it was a beautiful clear night sky. He allowed the binoculars to rest and glancing back observed flare-like brilliant objects descending in a southerly direction. They seemed in a disciplined formation each keeping a defined distance from each other.

The objects levelled out and began moving south very fast darting left and right. His view was obscured slightly by the thin vapour strata clouds. By the time he managed to view the spectacle through his binoculars he did not have enough time to discern any defined shape although they did appear to be boomerang shaped in the brief time that he observed them. He stated that after they levelled off they appeared to lose their brilliance and appeared grey in colour.

He estimated the speed of the objects around 500 –1000 mph and the sighting lasted for approx 20 seconds. He was certain there were 6 or 7 objects visible



Tuesday the 13th June,2000. Midnight

Mr. G.H.Parker of Bromborough, the Wirral, Merseyside, England. On Tuesday the 13th June 2000 Mr Parker went outside at 11.40 pm hoping to see the Russian Space Station MIRA. He then saw a small bright light, which was flashing and pausing and going on an erratic course ahead, then sideways, then backwards at a different angle. This lasted 2 minutes, after which it accelerated away in a Westerly direction, at terrific speed.

It was now just on midnight when scanning the sky still for MIRA he saw six large Objects flying from West to North. The Objects were two ahead and behind four, all were grey and brightly illuminated with long windows. They went across the sky smoothly and fairly fast. He was totally awe struck and felt they were threatening, but this is an obvious reaction from someone who had never given a thought to the subject of UFOS and didn't know much about them. He is the neighbour of Ron Caldys daughter and that was how I was put in touch with him. Mr. Caldys is an elderly retired naval officer living in Merseyside whom I have been acquainted with for a few years.

On Thursday the 15th June approx.9.15 pm

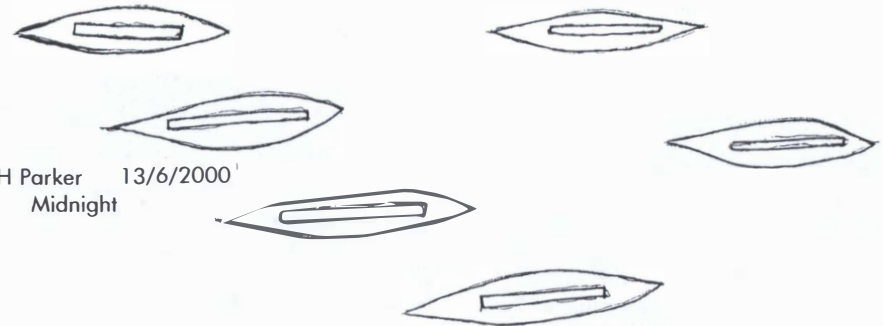
Report by S.Pryce-Williams one of two Chefs of the Stamford Gate Hotel, Holywell, North Wales on the coast by the Dee Estuary were standing talking, when they spotted very high up in the sky a very large, shiny Object. They estimate it was about 40,000 ft up, so it must have been enormous for them to see it so large. It was moving above them, and then went over the Dee Estuary towards the Wirral. Then this light came out from the side of the trees at about 200 ft off the ground. It was like a golden metallic electric light bulb placed horizontally. Margaret was staggered and speechless as behind this came 5 further golden metallic 'light bulbs' in formation behind the leader. She then watched them fly on in a steady formation quite silently over the landscape until they faded into the distance over the Dee Estuary. She then called out, the men had gone on talking and not seen anything.

Next morning she rang HTV, Liverpool, they weren't interested, "they behaved as though she was a nut". She wrote to Patrick Moore, going to the trouble of purchasing a metallic gold pen to illustrate for him what she saw. He replied that it was debris from a satellite. How can debris fly in formation on a set route, she asked me. She also rang Jodrell Bank and was told a person in Bury,Lancashire had made the same report for the same time. Her adult children were at the Pub in Llanfair TH village (5 miles from Llangernyw) when they joined in a conversation with people who had seen these six objects the previous evening also. At the time they did not know about their Mother's sighting. When they did, they went back to find these people but they were unknown to the publican. I asked why she did not ring me, she said she was sorry, she did not remember as Moore and HTV were a waste of time.

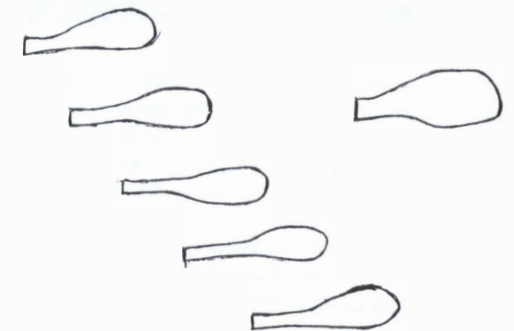

REPORT FROM MARGARET FRY, NORTH WALES CONVENOR.

In spite of the late start to the 2001 season of mid-May, crop circles or more typically, formations, were seen in English fields until mid-September. The phenomenon remained technically at the level of previous years until August, when two mind boggling events occurred within a week. These were a huge fractal design of 409 circles at Milk Hill, Wilts - easily the greatest number of circles to be included in one design; and a representation of a SETI message sent out in 1974, together with an adjoining "face" made by impressing the wheat in a unique fashion, found at Chilbolton, Hants. They are described in detail overleaf.

With the advantage of websites giving instant information, a fairly clear picture is available on the distribution of British formations in 2001. When known hoaxes and scientific experiments are eliminated, a figure of 82 formations is at present estimated for the UK (all in England). This is certainly less than in the past 2 seasons but the first sighting was a month later than average.

The following tables show various distributions of formations:

1. COMPLEX DESIGNS. Author estimates 45/82 in this category (55%). These are designs showing exceptional geometry and symmetry usually with more than 10 component parts.

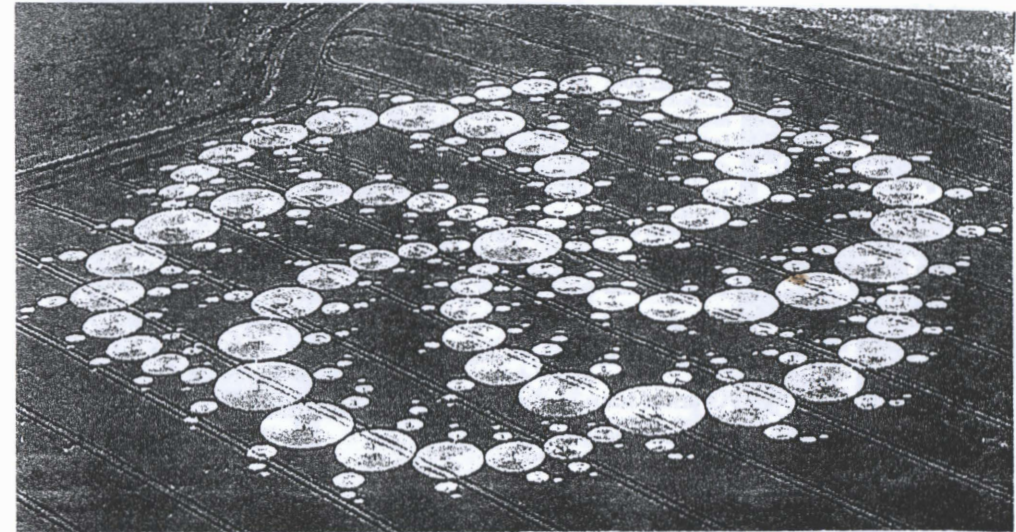
The above data is subject to additions, particularly from areas where there are few observers. Some of the overseas designs match the quality of English ones, as can be seen in the early rapeseed designs from Germany. We see in 2001 nearly all British activity looks to have been in the southern counties - Kent/Sussex/Hants/Wilts/Somerset with the "hotspot" again being within 10 miles of Avebury, Wilts, wherein all 38 formations believed not man-made were located, as was also the case in year 2000. Extremely low activity was noted from counties to the north of the Wiltshire glut this year, with the usual concentrations in Oxfordshire, Leicester, Shrops and Staffs, all well down on previous seasons. Only some good quality formations in Yorkshire saved a complete blank north of the Trent.

Nearly all the 82 British formations listed were more than just "simple circles", which

according to some of the theories expressed last year, are the only "genuine" ones. Complex designs are not just confined to Wiltshire. This year we had two outstanding formations in the Gog and Magog Hills, Cambridge, with fine radial lines in the structure; another handsome design close to Barton Le Clay, Bedfords; a large sprawling design with many circles near Kenton, South Devon; and several noteworthy ones in Hants, Sussex and Somerset.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SEASON: Milk Hill Formation, August 13th:

After a large number of similar shield/Mandala designs in Wiltshire up to early August, the phenomenon seemed to be marking time with nothing more complex than in year 2000. A sudden glut of man-made activity in the area in late July either as research experiments, sets for film makers, or good copies by "Team Satan" seemed to set up a challenge for the true "circlemakers" to get one jump ahead again. It at last happened on Sunday/Monday night, August 12-13th, in poor weather conditions at the top of Milk Hill above a White Horse. The formation illustrated is a 6 arm "Julia Set" type which last appeared in such detail in 1996, when a 3 arm version appeared at nearby Windmill Hill following a single arm prototype at Stonehenge the same year.



Each arm consists of 68 circles radiating out from one central circle making a total of 409 over 6 arms - the largest number of circles seen in one design so far. Individual sizes range from 3ft to 75ft. Some estimates state the design is 1,500 ft across, but is more likely 750-800 ft. A square of 250 yards x 250 yards gives 62,500 sq yards or approximately 13 acres.

In considering if this could be man-made - the circles can be easily constructed, but obtaining the perfect symmetry of the 409, nigh on impossible in the dark. An accurate survey would take hours to carry out over this size of area. Each circle would need to be sighted by poles to locate their position without damaging crop - almost impossible. If 2 men took 5 minutes to make each circle, 409 would take require 2045 minutes or 34 hours - a day and a half. To complete the job in one night something like 20 men taking no more

than 10 minutes per circle would be needed, and these would need to be co-ordinated with military precision. The field is about a mile from the nearest made up road and 2 miles from the nearest village, so as no permission was made to make this giant glyph, is it possible for it to have been trampled on one very wet August night?

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SEASON: Arecibo Message/Face at Chilbolton, Hants.

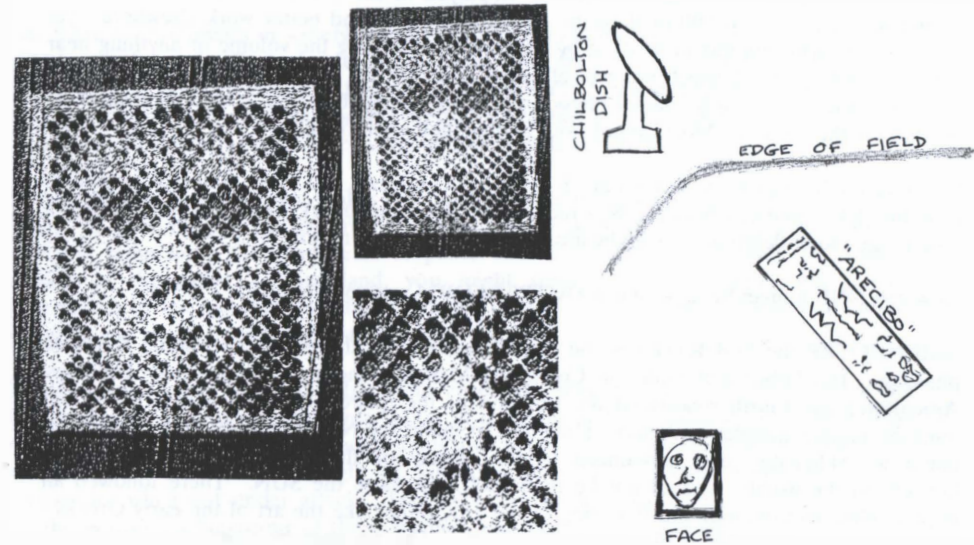
A remarkable pair of glyphs of unique construction appeared in a wheat field adjacent to the Chilbolton radio telescope, Wherwell, Hants, c August 19th. A long rectangle shape was found pointing directly at the dome of the radio telescope. This was soon recognised as as very similar to the message sent out in binary form to outer space from the Arecibo telescope centre, Puerto Rico, on November 16th, 1974. **COULD THIS BE THE REPLY?** The message was designed to be picked up by an intelligent race who would identify the binary information in a matrix of 23 x 73 pulses (both prime numbers). Unfortunately the message was directed at globular cluster M13 and would not reach there for 250 centuries. By 2001 the message would not have reached a star system of any kind. Thus the scientific community have dismissed this as a "prank" irrespective of the crop glyph which only makes sense when viewed from the air. Details of the possible information conveyed are shown in the illustration below. The speculation could go to several pages so please consult websites quoted for more facts.

The strange "picture frame" containing a "face" was placed obliquely in the same field as the Arecibo rectangle. It comprises of hundreds of tiny flattened circles which appear as a mess on the ground, but the aerial view reveals a satanic looking face similar to the general appearance of the Martian "face" in Cydonia - however we must not jump to conclusions! (See various magnifications). The method behind the construction is simple printing

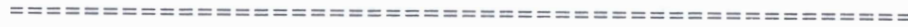
technique as seen in any newspaper picture, where the image is made from thousands of dots of different thicknesses. The dots are replaced by many small circles impressed into the wheat here. Who or what could do this on such a scale?

What we have is a typical enigma set by the "circlemakers". Something recognisable from our past or present is laid down in a field. Could it be a message from an alien intelligence? The scoffers, mainly from the scientific community, could only accept some high-tech response on their terms, but, as we have seen several times in the last ten years, our knowledge is intercepted and played back to us. Possibly vital information is contained in the Arecibo glyph concerning the nature of alien visitors, but more likely it is telling us very little. The originators could, but do not want to speak directly to us humans as they consider us too flawed mentally, so now and again they produce an overt demonstration of their presence. Many excited researchers latch on to the information relayed and use it to launch some unsustainable theory, but as we see year after year, we are still completely in the dark as to the nature of what we are dealing with - probably the way they want it to be.



CONCLUSIONS 2001: Can we expect this advancing phenomenon to reappear every year (now 22) if it is not intelligence driven? Consider the sorry state of human longevity at present. We are of course living longer, but the average survival in a job is now 2-3 years, and a marriage 5-10 years. Since 1980 hair fashions and dress have changed 5 or more times, so are we to believe that a generation of pranksters has carried on the same old stunt for 22 years and not become bored?

HYBRID DEMIGODS AMONG US

Are there visitors amongst us - people of such great freedom, initiative, intellect, technoskill and self control? Are these alien hybrids improving our lot, (and sadly needed when political and religious terrorists can destroy so much - eg World Trade Center, lower Manhattan) and raising humankind from basal strife and the stiffness of the bush culture that once covered much of the world - squalid. Consider NICOLA TESLA who was an impoverished immigrant when he entered the USA. In 1881 he had graduated in Physics at Cartstatt, Croatia, and was always drawn to inventing new and better machines in what was then the whitehot electrical revolution that was happening in the USA. He then founded the Tesla Electrical Company and produced the first design for the brushless electric motor and an improved method of arc lighting, and this was followed by hundreds of patents including transformers. The National Grid was a Tesla concept, the high voltage being his idea - those huge cables on the grid carry only 1.4 amps - less than the current going to a toaster! Consider that in Hungary he was employed in the extraction of cube roots, and having reached about 50,000 of these he decided he might find better work elsewhere - yet always keeping his interest in working by threes and estimating the volume of anything near him like books or food, which was typically seen as eccentric. Before travelling to the USA, he had mastered not only maths, physics and engineering, but also 2 or 3 languages he needed for the journey. Most cannot even master their own tongue.

Consider the level of his achievement: 3 languages, 3 subjects and many hundreds of patents including teleautomaton boat (1898, a radio controlled submarine); Tesla coil (high voltage); long range radio; defensive energy beams; many new types of motor.

How can ONE human being so much OUTPERFORM everyone else??

AMENHOTEP the FOURTH was the son of Amenhotep the third, the Middle Kingdom pharaoh. His father had built the Colossi of Memnon and many other huge buildings. Amenhotep the fourth renounced the tradition of the pharaoh as god; moved south and built the temple complex at Amarna (1600BC) to found the New Kingdom. He changed his name to Akhenaton and announced to the dismay of the priestly establishment that henceforth the worship should not be to himself, but more the SUN. There followed an unparalleled development and flowering of the arts, rather like the art of the early Greeks - small statuettes of children playing, and so forth. The enemies he made that day finally caught up with him and reestablished much of the status quo, destroying much of what he had achieved at Amarna. Did the "hippy" pharaoh who said: "Hell, let's go south and worship the sun", achieve nothing? In fact no, since much survives, and the religion of the state was modified to include the sun.

Yet how could anyone with that upbringing and traditional culture develop in such a DIFFERENT, liberating and positive way - almost like illumination by a Muse, or the action of a Space Brother. In fact, physiologically, Akhenaton is distinct from his parents and also had strange aquiline features.

I SWEDENBORG is the man after which Sweden was named, and from which much of the character of modern Sweden derives. Born in 1688, he was the son of a Lutheran bishop, and was until the age of 55, a scientist and mineralogist publishing "Opera Philosophica et Mineralia" in 1727. He worked for the mining industry and acquired an understanding of

physiology and anatomy. Later he became more religious, working on a practical implementation of Christian values in society, for example the abolishment of property. He channelled from many alien, spiritual and deic sources into the books - ARCANA CELESTIA (strange skies), HEAVEN AND HELL, THE DIVINE LOVE AND WISDOM, CONJUGIAL LOVE, THE TRUE CHRISTIAN RELIGION, THE NEW JERUSALEM and his channellings mainly in TELLURIBUS IN UNIVERSIO (worlds in space). His religious ideas were so modern that in the early fifties the FBI kept a file on him which is quite an achievement for someone from the 18th century. America and Canada had Swedenborgian communes. His very worthwhile books in english can be obtained from the Swedenborg Society, London WC1A 2TH.

HOMO NORMALIS (Joe Public) continues as useful and fruitful and childlike as ever. HOMO HYPERUS a sub-race of hybrid geniuses - such as AKHENATEN, CHAUCER, SWEDENBORG, PLATO, TESLA and PAULING - seem to work in society, yet have they ever organised outside recognising the dragging effect Homo Normalis has on them? Their work has been debased, dragged down and muddled into charmless directions continually.

Note there are "yy" males in society, a mutation for physical leadership in battle. That there could be a cultural, intellectual mutation also is not too far fetched. YET COULD THESE EXCEPTIONS BE VISITORS CLEARING THE WAY? Suppose that these do exist, and that whenever the culture stagnates, individuals or heretics in some cultures arise and move the culture one notch forward while everyone else crowds in behind.

Now one can surmise that what makes a tribe degenerate is the fact that a particular gene is missing, or when religion has too great a grip on a landlocked state. For example, Tibet was much the same for a thousand years of peace but very little progress until the Chinese invasion in the fifties. Switzerland, you might suppose, is only kept from intense conservatism by the fact that their funiculars and other inventions need innovative attention! A Switzerland in the tropics could stagnate.

The contention that, in origin, the white races are maritime and the black races are terrestrial leads naturally to the demarkation of strengths and weaknesses. The whites have necessarily to have the restless though innovative nature of sailors and fishermen, whereas the blacks will have static strength of kingdoms like the Pharaohs, which are natural matriarchies when not under attack. HUMAN PERCEPTION

When we observe an object (apple, house, person, seaside, the moon, a panoramic view etc., energy patterns, emanating from it, pass through the eyes. It is marvellous how the brain then interprets, processes or changes this energy input into the image we perceive. So in any observation we do not perceive wave patterns of energy as intricate colours and form, an analogy would be the waves seen rising from the road on a hot summer's day. Our brain causes a deception when we are prevented from perceiving an absolute reality. An appreciation of a truer perception can be found in the film, "Predator I or II" when the alien passed 'in and out' of reality, changing like a chameleon.

Our environment consists of an infinite mixture of waves of energy and frequencies, all intertwined like a ball of string with its hundreds of individual strands which constitute the cable. A multi-dimension of fibres contained within a sphere. When a radio or television, a receiver, is tuned to a particular frequency sound and vision materialise. Returning to the visible region, normal human's reality, the different atoms of the 100 chemical elements, like hydrogen, oxygen, aluminium, gold, silver, chlorine are its building blocks and light enables us to view it. In fact the SEVENS can only be seen by another SEVEN. Oh! No, not numbers again I hear you sighing.

(LIGHT is required to view the OBJECTS of Creation).

Seven is used in the scriptures as the number of perfection. In the sacred books and in the religion of the Jews, a great number of events and mysterious circumstances are set forth by the number seven. The seventh day was consecrated by God, the day of rest on which he ceased from the works of creation. This day is honoured by the Jews as well as every seventh year which is known as a sabbatical year and seven times seven or forty nine years which is known as a Jubilee. In the bible are found numerous references to the number seven when a week often stands for seven years. Jacob served his father-in-law for seven years; Pharaoh's mysterious dreams represented to his imagination seven full ears of corn, seven fat oxen and seven lean ones. In Isaiah it is written that seven women should lay their hold of one man; Hannah the mother of Samuel says that she who is barren should have seven children. These are just a few of the many examples of where seven is used in the bible.

The book of Revelations is the last one in the bible, consisting of 22 chapters, and it contains an abundance of numbers in its text. It seems to be the tale of an apocalyptic vision in which the seer, St John, rises to heaven, during which the Lamb takes possession of a book of the divine plan, and opens its 7 seals one by one. Seven trumpets given to seven angels underline the various forms of the punishments which will occur to the evil dwellers of the world. It is that strange reference to the number 7 is made over fifty times, so it must have some important significance.

Could it be connected with the 7 day creation of the universe, or the perfection, completion, purifying or fulfilment that the number 7 depicts in other books in the bible? Or does it hide some special scientific and spiritual message that humans will not be able to comprehend until they have become sufficiently adept in scientific knowledge and understanding? I believe that time has now been reached.

Physicists have developed scientific apparatus which can detect and measure the large as well as the miniscule or infinitesimal. They hydrogen atom for example is known to be just 0.074 nanometre small. A nanometre is one thousand millionth of a metre of 0.000000001 metre. On the metric scale then, scientists could refer to they hydrogen atom as 74, omitting the decimal point and nanometre. Or even as '45981468' mile in British or Imperial scale of measurement. The last answer is achieved by dividing '74' firstly by 2.54, and then by 63360, since 2.54 centimetres are equivalent to one inch, and there are 63360 inches in a mile. If the answer '45981468' miles is divided by 720 miles, the digits contained in the new result are 331066 or 331 ignoring the integers after the zero. This result 331, is purely a number without units because in effect it was obtained by finding how many times 720 miles would go into 45981468 miles. And the solution was 331.

Seven hundred and twenty miles is an intriguing amount since it enables components like the length of atoms, the diameters of the Sun and its planets and the distances between the heavenly spheres to be changed into just numbers. The Earth, Moon and Sun diameters of 7920, 2160 and 864000 miles convert to the numbers 11, 3 and 12(00). And the mean Earth to Moon distance of a quarter million miles, and the distance of the Sun from the Earth of about ninety three million miles become 347222 and 1291677 respectively. These numbers are more precisely 347 and 13, when the distances considered are 249840 and 93.6 million miles respectively. Numbers for the planets Uranus, the seventh from our Sun, and Pluto, the ninth are 7 and 2. I wonder if it is just a coincidence that the number values of the diameter of the planet Uranus and its distance from the Sun are identical. The number SEVEN.

If we return to the hydrogen atom, divine number 331, it can be seen that the addition of its component digits, 3 plus 3 plus 1, also make 7. This manipulation is known as fadic addition. So hydrogen has the fadic number or value of 7. Here are the numbers of some other well known atoms, helium, 304, a gas used in festival balloons which will make you speak with a squeaky voice if you inhale it. Carbon, 691, the black stuff found in chimneys when we used to burn coal, and oxygen, 655 one of the gases in the air which keeps us alive. Aluminium used in cooking utensils has the number 1132 and chlorine in bleaches is 880.

The six chemical elements essential to our being are hydrogen, oxygen, nitrogen, carbon, sulphur and phosphorus. Some of the others required are copper, zinc, iron, cobalt, calcium, potassium and sodium.

Notice that the fadic number of these atoms and indeed all the other one hundred or so known to scientists is seven. Carbon is 6 plus 9 plus 1 makes 16, and then 1 plus 6 equals 7. Thus each of the atoms, of all the one hundred or so chemical elements which constitute the matter found on planet Earth, has the value of SEVEN.

And each human is made of exactly the atoms of the same chemical elements, the sevens. Does this correspond with the number 7 frequently mentioned in Revelations?

Now when beams of the three primary colours of light rays are red, green and blue are mixed or shone together, the result is a white or invisible light ray. Invisible or Sun light consists of seven colours red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet, which can be seen in a rainbow or when light is passed through a glass prism.

Some cut glass objects will cause a similar effect. White light then, contains four "hidden" colours which we can find out about by means of a rainbow or cut glass, as well as its three primary ones. We could represent light as comprising the numbers 347(1), meaning 3 primary plus the four hidden colours add up to seven. When mixed these colours make one, invisible or white light.

Later God tells John to write down in a book what he sees and send it to the 7 churches which are in Asia.

When John turned to see the voice that spoke to him, he saw 7 golden candlesticks, and in the midst of these he saw someone like the Son of man. In his right hand he had 7 stars and out of his mouth went a sharp 2-edged sword. Jesus said that "I am the first and the last, that I am he that lived and was dead; and behold I am alive for evermore, ... and have the keys of hell and of death. The mystery of the 7 stars is that they are the 7 angels of the 7 churches and the 7 golden candlesticks are the 7 churches.

The gold, a rare and valuable metal from which the candlesticks are made, puts an emphasis on the importance of the number 7. For 7 depicts hydrogen atoms, plentiful in the very beginning, and immensely invaluable, the prime ingredient needed to generate atoms of all the other chemical elements required for the construction of matter on planet Earth.

Our physicists have a theory called the "Big Bang Theory", an event which scientists think took place between 10 and 20 billion years ago, when a singularity of infinite density "exploded". The matter produced by it eventually settled to the vast universe of stars and galaxies we now perceive. A singularity of infinite density is easily describable as a point or speck in which all the "matter" of our universe was contained, but it defies the imagination. How can one even picture the whole of a fifty ton lorry squashed to occupy the space of a water droplet, or the enormous energy and pressure it would require to squash it?

Electrons are negatively charged and flow in all electrical circuits. Simply imagined an ordinary hydrogen atom consists of a central proton and one orbiting electron. There are two other kinds of hydrogen atoms called deuterium and tritium. These, unlike normal hydrogen, contain additional neutral particles known as neutrons, which make them heavier. Thus there are three isotopes (kinds) of hydrogen. After the Big Bang it is thought that the first particles produced in the initial immense release of energy were quarks, which later associated to make protons, the positive electrically charged particle present in the nucleus of all atoms. A proton can be considered as an hydrogen ion, since to become an atom of hydrogen it needs to acquire just one electron.

"Heavy water" contains deuterium, which the German scientists were trying to isolate and manufacture during the Second World War, an ingredient essential for the atomic bomb.

Atoms of all of the other chemical elements then came into being by reactions, often accompanied by energy readjustments, firstly between pairs of protons which produced normal hydrogen and electrons. Some of the hydrogen then reacted with other protons to make helium, the next chemical element. Followed by the formation of beryllium, boron, carbon, nitrogen, oxygen,..... and so on, by interaction between atoms, protons and electrons.

Both Earth and the planet Pluto have 2 as their number, and are depicted by the 2-edged sword, and 7 stars represent Uranus, which as 7 as its number. A candlestick belongs to its particular church, and is a component of it.

Both the church and its candlestick are comprised of chemical matter, represented by the sevens. Another 7 is depicted by the 7 stars, and is the planet Uranus in human consciousness. But in God consciousness this interprets differently into something equally as special as atoms. For this 7 is the spirit or soul to be injected into the church, which is in reality earth matter. In other words it is needed to give earth matter life as a human being.

So 27 means the connected planets Pluto (2) and Uranus(7), or the planet Earth (11=2) made of the atoms (7) of the chemical elements or earth matter (2) containing spirit (7).

Patterns and relationships involving numbers, like in the different atoms, exist everywhere in the universe and the following will demonstrate my last example. Recall that as numbers the distances of the Earth from and Sun and the Moon are 13 and 347. Sunlight is also 13, invisible (1) made of the three primary colours (3). The number 347 was discussed above in light rays and now it appears as a distance phenomenon. Both light from the Sun and the distance between the Earth and Moon have the same value, 347. Two entirely different perceptions, or duality, can be represented by the same concept. The concept of numbers, which is what the book of Revelations is about. What is now needed is a translation of those conceptual numbers in the light of scientific knowledge.

Objects of God's creation have individual, significant numbers when perceived in absolute of God consciousness.

These objects are discerned in a different way in human consciousness because each of us relies on the brain to interpret the information we collect through our sense organs, such as our eyes for images. Therefore the planets Pluto and Uranus will be 2 and 7 in absolute or God consciousness. In human consciousness they will appear as luminous spheres when viewed through a telescope.

In chapter 1 verses 15-16 we can read that "in the midst of the 7 candlesticks one like unto the Son of man...and he had in his right hand 7 stars: and out of his mouth went a 2 edged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength." Literally this means that the numbers 2 and 7, in God consciousness, or Pluto and Uranus in human consciousness, give the Son of man much happiness. What nonsense this would have been if John had written it this way! So he attaches the percepts sword and star to each of the concepts 2 and 7 which produce an enigma.

Chapter 12 starts with "and there appeared a great wonder in heaven;..." This can be regarded as actuality or human consciousness when John writes in this vein.

John often makes the descriptive use of clouds, noise, lightning's and great thunderings in his writing. Some people think that these might relate to engines or the propulsion units of unidentified flying machines. I think he employs them to give an atmosphere to his narrative, like the build up of clouds do, prior to the thunderclaps and lightning's of our thunder storms.

It is also intriguing that Revelations consists of 22 chapters, the male number 2 and female number 2. And 2 plus 2 makes 4, the vibrational number of the spirit which resides in each of us. Also 2 times 11 is equivalent to 22, the number of chapters in this book. And 11 is the number of planet Earth, 2 is its fadic value, the number achieved by the addition of the constituent digits of 11, that is 1 plus 1. Was this intended as another conundrum?

During our lives if we can raise our spiritual awareness, then this has the effect of increasing the vibrational level of the spirit within, from four to seven.

Whence the soul has become completed, purified and perfected, enabling it to unite with and live in the Kingdom of God in accordance with biblical knowledge.

It is time to consider the first chapter of Revelations – "the number seven".

Initially God welcomes John when he greets him with: "John to the 7 churches which are in Asia: grace be unto you and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the 7 spirits before his throne; and from Jesus Christ."

John is told to write the things which he saw, the things that are and the things that shall be hereafter, and the mystery of the 7 stars in the right hand and the 7 golden candlesticks. The 7 stars are the angels of the 7 churches, and the 7 candlesticks and the 7 churches. God is placing emphasis on the number 7, the number needed to initiate and produce all the matter we perceive. Hydrogen atoms and all the other one hundred or so different atoms which comprise matter on Earth. Thus copper aluminium, iron for example and all the other elements are "forms" of hydrogen and can be regarded as equivalent. So a candlestick is the same as a church, since both can be regarded as components of each other.

The (7) stars, the other type of seven, constitute the spirit contained within the churches. This implies that earth matter or certain structures made of it are endowed with spirit.

Humans definitely are.

A LOAD OF BALLS?

Occasional photographs have been taken with a basic camera using flash at various locations in twilight and full darkness. Over a 7 year period I have captured majestic spirals, odd fogging and globes which may be semi-transparent or opaque. The latter have been dismissed as water droplets interacting with optics of the camera, but nothing can explain the spirals. Since my earlier work in 1994-5, when I managed to get spirals on 4 occasions, they have not been present on my more recent photographs, but other people have picked them up. The latest I am aware of was taken by Ellis Taylor, our colleague from Perth, Australia, who on his summer visit to England had two instances of complete picture break down and spirals appearing instead on daylight photographs he took at a mystical spot, St Nectan's Glen, near Tintagel, Cornwall, October 2001. (Website: www.ellistaylor.com)

This year, 2001, on my visit to Seaton, Cornwall, where I stay with our Hon. Life Member, Derek Mansell, I took a sequence of shots at 10pm on May 27th and May 28th walking up from the sea front to high ground along a chine. I found the photos taken on the first night were heavily marked with globes. This particular day had been a complete loss, as a sea fret had come down making visibility barely a few yards and a very fine drizzle was present most of the time. On firing off the flash, minute raindrops could be seen in their thousands, but on the developed pictures, there are only a few much larger globes discernible which become more elliptical towards the edges of the frame. The last 5 in the sequence taken were at a deserted copse at the top of the road. Exactly the same view was taken at one minute intervals. The balls produce a different pattern each time indicating they are not an effect of water drops on the lens of the camera, and are moving quickly. In the two illustrated examples overleaf, a very large globe appears to be BEHIND the twig on the bush in the centre. The final shot I took that night shows two massive, solid looking globes, very close together behind the twig. They must be about a foot in diameter.

On the following night, May 28th, there were no anomalies on the replicated sequence of pictures. It was still very cloudy but not raining. The cloud base had risen considerably during the day. Globes have appeared on photographs when it is not raining, but not often in very dry conditions. On the other hand when it is pouring with rain they may not be present; instead there are fuzzy outlines which is clearly the effect of rain. TV pictures

taken at football matches in wet conditions often show hexagonal shaped lights particularly when the camera is pointing towards the floodlights. This is definitely due to camera aperture size and shape and distortions due to moisture.

We may have an energy form (intelligent?) that comes down with rain from within the clouds, but there is an even split between those that dismiss it entirely and those that think it is something special. (Janet Ossebaard, Netherlands, who is producing videos of anomalous lights over crop circles, has a number of similar globe pictures taken in Holland. She is confident it is a real phenomenon). I shall now try to see under what variations in weather the globes will appear. Of course nothing is apparent to the human eye so this makes investigation hit and miss. It does seem that CORNWALL is very positive in producing strange effects on films - so do have a try if visiting the county.

THE BONSALL (DERBY) UFO: There appears to be a great deal of controversy in the popular press and also the July issue of "UFO Magazine" over the contents of the Mrs Sharon Rowlands "Bonsall" UFO video.

I would like to clarify the situation and to give what I consider a true assessment of the incident.

Following a UFO report in the "Matlock Mercury", 19th October, 2000, I visited Mr and Mrs Rowlands at their home on Friday 20th October and studied their UFO video. This was only some two weeks after the event date of 5th October 2000. Incidentally their remote cottage is not situated in Bonsall, but in the hamlet of Slaley about a mile and a half away from the village of Bonsall.

We discussed the incident in detail and Mr and Mrs Rowlands described what they had seen and also their feelings at the time.

On the night of the 5th of October 2000 at about 9.15pm the couple were sitting in their lounge, which has an excellent window view overlooking the nearby Middleton Wood situated approx. 1½ miles away. Their attention was attracted by a bright circular light that suddenly appeared and hovered over the distant trees.

The couple were so alarmed by the unusual appearance and brightness of the light; they decided to video it with their 8mm camcorder. Mrs Rowlands located the camcorder and then leaning against the open doorway, proceeded to film the glowing light.

At first it just hovered as a brilliant ball of light over the nearby woods, but after a few minutes it began to approach their isolated cottage. "It seemed to know we were there looking at it" commented Mrs Rowlands. Within seconds the ball of light grew in size until a circular darker pattern could be seen in the light. Then quite suddenly the light withdrew to its previous position over the woods, where it hovered once more.

Within two to three minutes the glowing ball began to move slowly to the right (NW) and a pulsating light could be seen forming on the left-hand side of the glowing ball. It then began to increase its speed and at that stage it appeared to turn away from the witnesses, revealing two smaller bright light sources (*as though viewing the rear of a twin jet with afterburners switched on*). Then in a split second it disappeared out of sight. The whole incident had taken place in only six and a half minutes.

Until then, neither Mr nor Mrs Rowlands had taken any interest in the subject of UFOs or in fact considered that they actually existed. They both commented on the fact that the whole incident took place in complete silence and they had a feeling that the object was under intelligent control.

I viewed the UFO footage several times on their TV set and studied it intently. Unfortunately it was not possible to study the individual frames. Mrs Rowlands promised to arrange for a VHS copy to be made for me for further evaluation and analysis. However when I telephoned her a few days later, she had changed her mind and stated she intended to keep the video for herself. At that time, Mr and Mrs Rowlands had already declined to

show the video to the BBC News or get involved with the TV media.

At no stage did anyone mention that the UFO was three miles across! I consider the probable size was about 50 ft diameter. The mention of "three miles across" probably originated during a discussion on the similarity of the "Rowlands" light to that of a light source filmed by NASA during the tether/UFO encounter on the STS-75 mission. At the time NASA describes the UFO as being "some 2-3 miles in diameter".

The pattern in the glowing circle of light has also been questioned, with some sources claiming that the image pattern is due to the lens design inherent in the camcorder. This is probably magnified as a result of the "automatic" setting on the camcorder attempting to bring the light source into focus.

While I believe it difficult to believe that the sum of £20,000 has been paid for the "Bonsall" footage, I understand from reliable media sources that this is indeed the case. In my opinion the sequence is no more spectacular than many of the world-wide extracts shown in a Michael Hesemann archive documentary.

There are many books currently doing the rounds regarding UFOs and aliens, most of them stating that they have the 'answers', that they know what is behind the UFO mystery, here is another one, another book which claims to, at the very least, hold some 'insight' as to what truly lies behind the age old mystery of why the 'aliens' are here, their purpose, and ultimately their place in today's UFO climate. This book looks at not only the UFO abduction phenomenon, but also the possibility that certain Governments of this world, actually are in some kind of collaboration with these 'aliens', more so the American Government, of whom the author states, that the U.S. Government may intend to use some 'alien' technology that they have recovered over the years.

The author also looks at contactees throughout the ages, in particular the late George Adamski who claims to have met aliens in a Californian desert back in November 1952, he also looks at the claims made by Bob Lazar who claims to have seen 'alien' craft in an American base back in the 1980's. What is pleasing to this reviewer, is the fact that the author also look at our own technology and those strange devices that currently overfly our air space. Most of these, to the unsuspecting public, look fairly similar to many of the UFOs that are currently being reported throughout the world.

The author also touches upon ancient civilisations and the strange objects that they themselves reported in their skies. It's clear to see that the UFO phenomenon has been with us now throughout time itself, a fact that the author so rightly mentions. The reader is also given a run down of the more commonly reported 'aliens that have been seen, from the small greys, to the more hideous creatures that have terrified those unaware people. Although I found much in this book that I've read before, the author has his own opinions as to what is going on, and I won't spoil it for him by giving the game away here, suffice it to say that one may find in this book a significant amount of 'new material' which is a rarity these days, with numerous authors covering old ground. Whilst I agree, that one must touch upon cases that have went before, in as much as we must carefully study them to see if there are any similarities, too much of an 'old thing' can be tedious. Thankfully, Raymond's book covers much relevant and important issues, and is a step aside from the more current books available on the market today.

All in all then, Raymond's book adds to the growing weight of evidence and testimony which is currently gathering throughout the world today, and as such, should be read by believers and sceptics alike.

Albert Budden, who is well known to me, has been researching UFOs for many years now, and during those years he has developed and changed his way of thinking in regards to what may lie behind the UFO mystery. This is not Albert's first book on the subject of electromagnetic pollution, but this book certainly extends upon his theories and presents many more new cases from around the world to which he points out has '*nothing at all to do with the fanciful Flying saucer*'. Albert's research has clearly shown to him, that there is a natural mechanism behind the UFO mystery, and that mechanism not only explains UFO sightings, but also explains why people see Ghosts and experience paranormal effects. Essentially it is all down to electromagnetic stress, and where people live. Albert states that some people have the misfortune to live close by to E.M. 'Hot Spots' or areas which generate high examples of electromagnetic frequencies, this in turn, can cause them to experience 'visual effects' which in point of fact are not really there. These could take the form of a misty human figure shape, to a strange ball of light in the sky. Natural geoelectromagnetic emissions at locations over fault lines can also cause these effects. Albert also found, that some people who earlier in their lives had had the misfortune to have been in close proximity of a lightning strike affected their body and mind in which certain, what appeared 'paranormal effects' were observed. We learn that some individuals who have been exposed to prolonged irradiation of EM fields from environmental sources, experienced visual seizures, and generally displayed signs of epileptiform states, a condition of which Albert believes, explains the famous Livingston case in Scotland.

There are many sources of this EM pollution currently in use all over the UK. Radio Frequency transmitters, telecommunication towers, Military and Civil radar, power lines, high tension cables, transformers and sub stations, all combine to feed out into our landscape, emissions of which Albert believes can, under certain circumstances, cause certain individuals to suffer from a visual stimuli which in point of fact, has no bearing on reality. These people usually claim experiencing many childhood UFO and paranormal effects simply because they had lived close to an area of which emitted these type of frequencies. These people are also sometimes to be found suffering from food allergies, of which milk and wheat products, tobacco smoke, and perfume can prove to be very distressing to them. To review a book of this magnitude which covers many different aspects of the unusual, (ie, Out Of Body Experiences, Near Death Experiences, and such like) would be a tremendous task. [Beyond this small review]. This however is a very important book and should be read by sceptics and 'believers' alike. It has a strong message, and it carries a message that we should all listen to. A thought provoking book then, and one of which will go down as a highly controversial book in the annals of, not only UFOlogy, but of medical science as well. Strongly recommended.

Well where do I start ? Books on Scottish UFO sightings are few and far between, in fact to my knowledge, there ain't any, (less you consider Steuart's Campbell's attempt at discrediting all the major world's UFO reports !). Then along comes this one, The Benhar Encounter. A book which claims to deal with the two Scottish witnesses (man & wife), who stumble upon a strange spectacle occurring above some trees, more in a moment.

O.K. firstly we learn that the author who was in the early stages of writing this book, had a thief who struck in the night only to steal the disc that his book was stored upon. They left the computer, but just stole the disc. The author wonders why, so do I ! So what do you get for your 94 pages, yes, just **94 pages**, no more, no less, no index, no bibliography. Well you find that all along you were wrong !! you find that what Robert Taylor actually saw in Dechmont Woods near Livingston New town back in 1979, was not a domed shaped object with a flange going around it's perimeter, no sirc, what it really was, was an Adamski type Flying Saucer, there is even a drawing of this saucer in the woods. I've spent many hours with witness Bob Taylor, and he always maintained that the shape of the object he saw, was round, with a flange, not a blooming Adamski saucer. Bob's drawing does not show an Adamski saucer. Jeezzz !!

We then learn about the UFO sightings over and around the small town of Bonnybridge in Stirlingshire, incredibly these events are briefly skimmed over as though there were only one or two events there. A school kid could have presented more information on Bonnybridge. Granted the scope of this book *is not* about Bonnybridge, but come on, when you talk about the Great Fire of London, you don't just talk about the one house in which it started ! This isn't sour grapes because no Scottish group (including SPI) are mentioned in association with the events in Bonnybridge, it's purely because one would have expected a little more on what went on there. What we do find out though, is the author's speculation that perhaps the reason one gets UFO sightings over Bonnybridge, is because, *we are told*, there may be a point of magnetic disturbance where the Bonny Water (a local small river) meets up with the River Carron. Oh course, but didn't we just know that all along !

What is even more surprising, at least to me, is the fact that one of Scotland's most important UFO Abductions, that which occurred on the A70 in Central Scotland to good friends of mine, Garry Wood and Colin Wright, only merits 12 lines, yes **12 lines**. The author must have been burning the midnight oil on that one. The author then goes into some other UFO sightings in Scotland, all of which are new to me. But why Scotland the author asks ? Well on page 18 we find out, apparently Scotland has the purest water in the world, which would seem to attract 'beings' from other worlds to come here and partake of, (Like a Cosmological Tesco's !).

O.K. let's get to the incident proper, what's all this about the Benhar Encounter ? Well it occurred to two people, Bill and Sheila (husband & wife) who live in Fauldhouse West Lothian Central Scotland. On Sunday the 19th of March they took off in their car to visit friends. As they were driving down the B7066 in the direction of Harthill, they observed a tremendous white light in the sky which was accompanied by a strange 'humming' sound. There was a glow in the trees, and parts of the tree (the leaves), were being sucked up into the sky. They stopped the car, got out, and were shortly met by beautiful Nordic looking men, who kindly invited them aboard their space-craft. Not wanting to disappoint them, they kindly obliged, and began walking up a slopping ramp. Upon walking into the craft, they both became aware of an overpowering smell, like 'an electric smell', they also heard a soft whine coming from somewhere.

Conversation was by telepathy, and by way of a thank you, Bill rushed out of the 'craft', went back to his car, opened the glove compartment, and took out a bicycle light which he promptly gave to one of the Nordics. Their stay aboard this 'craft' was short lived, and after a period of time the event was closed and this Adamski type UFO, for that is what the witnesses saw, took off into the night. 18 months after this incident, both Bill and Sheila were at a party where they heard a man speaking about the UFO sightings over Bonnybridge. They spoke to him about their own UFO encounter, whereafter he suggested he could get someone to write a book about this event. This he did, a chap called Gilbert Nelson (a long time friend). Gilbert is not his real name. I can't understand why Gilbert didn't use his real name for the book. Why not, you've written a book for goodness sake, don't you want people to know who you are !!

The book then goes into discussing Greys, the Fourth Dimension, George Adamski, The Philadelphia Experiment, Fredrich Jurgenson (spirit voices on audio tape), the great 'scare-ship' wave of 1897, Near Death Experiences, Ley Lines, the 'greenhouse effect', why aliens are here, all subjects which are briefly skimmed over. Is this book just a novel, like the book "Flying Saucer From Mars". Or did these events really take place ? For a 5 minute 'on board' UFO experience, this book is no gripping read. I've problems with it . Why the Nordics, why the Adamski craft, why why why !! Come clean Gilbert Nelson, who are you, is your book a novel ??


